



Pre-Marriage/Wedding Covenant

- Both must be Christians. (First meeting, the pastor will ask for a clear conversion testimony from both candidates).
- At least one person should be a partner(member) of the Journey Church.
- The pastor will not agree to a wedding date until he has met with the couple together one-on-one.
- The pastor will expect both participants to do (3) pre-marital counseling sessions with him. Both must attend each session.
- The pastor will not marry couples that are living in blatant sin (i.e. living with one another, sexual promiscuity, etc).
- The pastor reserves the right not to marry the couple if he feels they are not prepared to be married.
- The couple agrees to pay \$300 to the pastor, \$150 for performing the ceremony and \$150 for premarital counseling, no later than the day of the wedding. (Check written to the pastor).
