Pre-Marriage/Wedding Covenant

- Both the future husband and the future wife must be Christians. (At the first meeting, the pastor will ask for a clear conversion testimony from both candidates.)
- Either the future husband or the future wife should be a partner (member) of the Journey Church.
- The pastor will agree to a wedding date once he has met with the couple together one-on-one.
- The pastor will expect both participants to do three pre-marital counseling sessions with him. Both must attend each session.
- The pastor will not marry couples living in sin (i.e. living with one another, sexual promiscuity, etc.).
- The pastor reserves the right not to marry the couple if he feels they are unprepared to be married.
- The couple agrees to pay \$300 to the pastor, \$150 for performing the ceremony and \$150 for premarital counseling, no later than the day of the wedding. (Check written to the pastor.)
